



POCKET ADDING APPARATUS UNIT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Kenneth R. Pangburn, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Duluth, in the county of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pocket Adding Apparatus Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof:

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a pocket adding apparatus unit with the cover opened, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side perspective view of the same in a closed condition, the opposite side presenting substantially the same appearance as the side shown.
