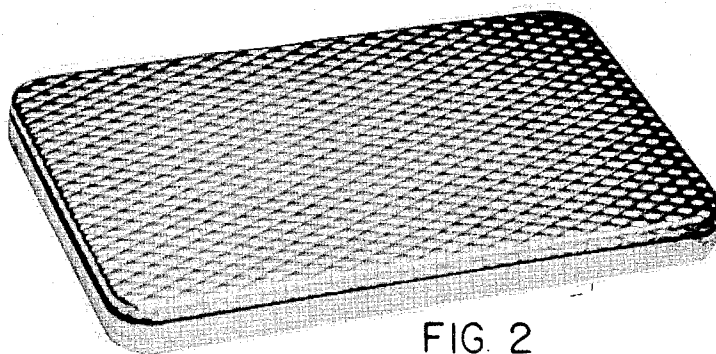

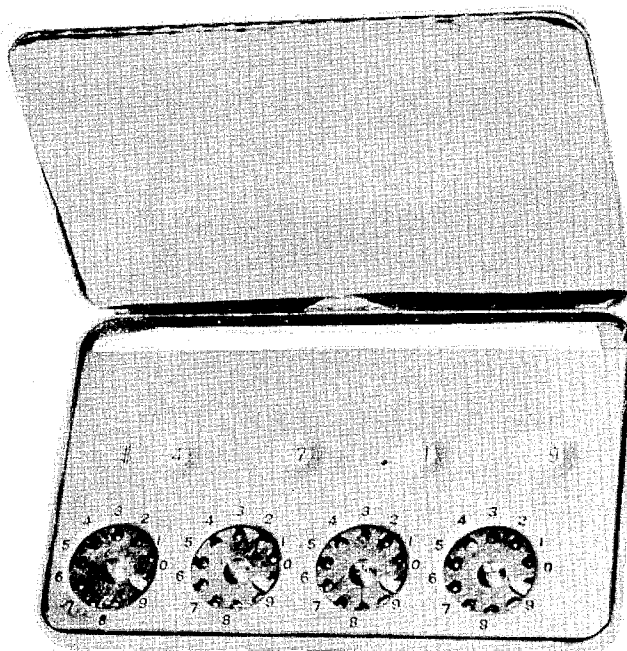

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Kenneth R. Pangburn, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Duluth, in the county of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pocket Adding Apparatus, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of the pocket adding apparatus, with the cover opened, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a perspective view of the same with the cover closed, the back of the design being plain.
